 - b) What was the final score of the most recent match between FC METTA and RIGA FC?
 - c) In their last match, how many yellow card penalties were issued to RIGA FC

- d) Who was the player that scored the opening goal in RIGA FC's latest game
- e) Which team has defeated RIGA FC the most times in the current season?
- f) Which opponent has suffered the most defeats by RIGA FC in this season
- g) In which matches did RIGA FC emerge victorious without conceding any goals this season?



Question 2: This part delves into the players performance metrics, such as the number of penalties they've incurred and identifying the top scorer, among others.



 - g) In the 2023 season, what jersey number did Ngonda Muzinga wear?



This is the first of two sources. Keep in mind the season selection dropbox in the right corner




