Description:

Question 2: This question should include current information about RIGA FC's performance in the Virsliga, specifically their recent wins, losses, and draws, along with the dates, penalties, first game scores and opponents they faced. To ensure that questions about game details are manageable for the user to answer, limit them to just the last match played by FC RIGA.

Questions:

1. UEFA Champions League, UEFA Europa League and UEFA Conference League
 - a) How many UEFA Champions League matches had RIGA FC participated in by August 2023?
 - b) As of August 2023, what's the number of matches RIGA FC lost in the UEFA Europa League?
 - c) Up to August 2023, how many UEFA Europa Conference League matches ended in a draw for RIGA FC?
 - d) By August 2023, what's the count of RIGA FC's victories in the UEFA Champions League?
 - e) Until August 2023, in how many UEFA league matches has RIGA FC faced defeat?
 - f) As of August 2023, how many victories has RIGA FC recorded in UEFA league matches?
 - g) By August 2023, what is the number of draws RIGA FC has achieved in UEFA league games?
 - h) What's the total number of UEFA league games played by RIGA FC as of August 2023?

2. Virsliga
 - a) What is the total number of matches RIGA FC participated in during the 2023 Virsliga season?"
 - b) What was the final score of the most recent match between FC METTA and RIGA FC?
 - c) In their last match, how many yellow card penalties were issued to RIGA FC

- d) Who was the player that scored the opening goal in RIGA FC's latest game
- e) Which team has defeated RIGA FC the most times in the current season?
- f) Which opponent has suffered the most defeats by RIGA FC in this season
- g) In which matches did RIGA FC emerge victorious without conceding any goals this season?
